White Wine

France

200. Saint Marc Grenache blanc, Pays d'Oc, France 750ml £31
Fresh, vibrant and bursting with aromas of grapefruit, pear and summer flowers with a joyful parade of lemon and lime flavours balanced by juicy acidity.
201. La Campagne, Viognier, Languedoc, France (V) £34
Dry with all the classic characteristics of the Viognier grape, exhibiting peaches, dried apricots and floral aromas.
202. Petit Ronde Picpoul de Pinet, Languedoc, France (V) £40
The mouth feel is delicate and has fresh notes of lemon/lime zest and pink grapefruit. The palate is full bodied - delicious ripe stone fruits, green apple and citrus with herb.
203. Domaine Du Haut Perron, Torraine Sauvignon Blanc, Loire, France £42
Elegance and richness would be the perfect descriptors, with notes of citrus, apricot, and passion fruit notes with toasted oak. Remarkably long on the finish with toasted oak, herbs, and a flinty salinity on the finish.
204. Boutinot La Fleur Solitaire Côtes du Rhône Blanc, Rhone, France (V) £45
Fresh, medium-bodied, with a pretty nose of delicate hedgerow flowers and stone fruits. The palate is lovely and fresh showing fresh stone fruits, pear, and green apple with a honeyed, mineral finish.
205. Pascal Clement, Macon Villages, Burgundy, France (V) £45
Floral and fruit aromas such as acacia and honeysuckle, lemongrass, and citrus mingle on a refreshing palate.
206. Chablis Fournillon, Burgundy, France £60
A classically styled Chablis, generously rounded with green apple, citrus and a rounded yet mineral finish.
207. Pouilly Fume 'Argile a' S' bouchie, Chatellier, Loire, France 2022 (V) £84
This is a fresh and beautifully aromatic, mineral and fruity Pouilly Fume, which is elegant, and has plenty of length and a full body. Sauvignon Blanc in one of its best forms.
208. Chablis Premier Cru Fourchaume Domaine Alexandre, Burgundy, France 2021 £95
Crisp and refreshing on the nose with an abundance of orchard fruit, citrus and subtle flint notes that follow through onto a rich mineral driven palate. The finish is long and luscious.
209. Louis Jadot, Puligny Montrachet, Côtes de Beaune, France 2015 £180
Distinctively Côte de Beaune, overflowing with generous rich barrique character and stylish stone-fruit charm.

England

210. Guinevere Gusbourne Chardonnay, Kent, England £65
Orchard fruit character, with ripe lemon, pear, quince and a touch of honeysuckle. On the palate, the wine is ripe, rounded, and brimming with bolder notes of nectarine and orange peel, yellow apple, and pineapple. Buttered toast, soft spice and a creamy texture combine with a salty mineral note and beautiful freshness on the finish.

Portugal

211. Vila Nova Vinho Verde, Portugal £35
Floral, citrus aromas lead on to a palate with more bright citrus acidity and a lingering finish with the perfect amount of spritz

Italy

212. Allumea, Organic Chardonnay/Grillo, Sicilia, Italy (V) 750ml £39
This wine has an elegant pale yellow hue, with intense aromas of pineapple and lemon. The palate is fresh and crisp, with a great minerality and a long and lingering finish.
211. Pecorino Terre di Chieti Feudo Antico, Aburzzo, Italy £40
A fruity nose with mineral and floral notes. Medium bodied with delicate fruit flavours and almond on the finish.
212. Ca' Bianca, Gavi, Piedmont, Italy £45
White flower and green fruit aromas, with a touch of honey and refreshing minerality on the palate.

Spain

214. Paco & Lola, Lolo Tree Albarino, Rias Baixas, Spain (V) £48
Notes of zippy, green apple and lemon peel with a hint of white-fleshed plum.
215. Ontañón Vetiver Rioja Blanco, Rioja, Spain (V) £50
Softly oak aged, with a balance between ripe tropical fruit and toasted brioche.

Germany

217. Walt Riesling Pfalz ,Germany (V) £42
Off-dry, this wine has lovely flavours of peach and stone fruits with a hint of apricot lingering on a bright, succulent finish.
218. Villa Wolf Gewürztraminer, Pfalz, Germany (V) £48
Clean, fruity and wonderfully light on its feet. With plenty of aromatic charm of elderflower, roses and lychee. Succulent and juicy on the palate with delicate stone fruits, spice notes and elderflower.

New World

219. Petal & Stem, Sauvignon Blanc, Awatere Valley, Marlborough, New Zealand 750ml £39
The wine expresses pure fruit flavours of guava and passionfruit, with underlying notes of grapefruit and blackcurrant leaf, combining to create a wine that is refreshingly zesty and nicely balanced on the finish.
220. Stellenrust Chenin Blanc, South Africa £39
This Chenin Blanc shows elements of soft vanilla oak notes on the nose, alongside tropical fruits with an mineral palate of grape fruit and peardrop.
221. Vavasour Pinot Gris , Awatere Valley, Marlborough, New Zealand (V) £45
Displays a richly structured palate featuring layers of ripe fruit, notes of ginger and the long mineral finish
222. El Enemigo, Semillon, Mendoza, Argentina £60
Wonderfully balanced, smooth, creamy white wine with aromas of tropical fruit, sweet spice and toast.

Orange Wine

210. Gerard Bertrand, Orange Gold, Occitanie, France (V) 750ml £55
The nose is complex, with an explosion of white flower notes, candied fruits, and white pepper. In the mouth, a flattering aromatic freshness, with precise flavours and a pleasing balance thanks to the structure that give body and spirit.



Red Wine

France

300. Saint Marc Cabernet Sauvignon, Pays d'Oc, France, (V) £31
Classic notes of red berry, blackcurrant and cherry fruits. Clean and persistent on the finish.
301. Jaffelin, Pinot Noir, Vin de Pays d'Oc, France (V) £34
A bouquet of explosive aromas of cherry and red fruits, with a soft complexity that is rich, yet still maintains great quality of tannins and great length.
302. M. Chapoutier, Cotes du Rhone Belleruche, France (V) £42
Intense, with blackcurrant and raspberry on the nose and hints of white pepper. Juicy, powerful, and full of red fruits on the palate.
303. Beaujolais-Villages, Mommessin Les Grandes Mises (V) £42
A refined, very elegant, powerful wine where the terroir is fully revealing. With a fine ruby-red colour with flavours of small berries, well rounded, soft tannins and good length.
304. Chateau Lyonnat, Lussac Saint Emilion, Bordeaux, France £46
A small district of St Emilion with a common terrain, the style is full of soft plums and brambly cassis flavours.
305. Château de Fleurie Maison Loron & Fils, Beaujolais, France (V) £60
Soft and silky with red cherry, raspberry, and a touch of earthy spice on the finish.
306. Bouchard Aine and Fils, Beaune Villages, France 2017 (V) £80
Cherry-red in colour, it shows red and black berry fruit on the nose and a note of vanilla on the palate.
307. Chateau l'Hopital de Mignot Saint Estephe, Bordeaux, France 2014 £82
This wine has a fruity and spicy nose, with a classic palette of cassis, cherry, liquorice and vanilla, all whilst displaying a full-bodied but delicate structure.
308. Châteauneuf du Pape, La Bernardine, M. Chapoutier, France 2021 £120
Made mainly from Grenache, with a proportion of Syrah and Mourvedre, this wine has aromas of roasted coffee, raspberry and plum. The palate builds on the plums with spicy liquorice and cinnamon.
309. Blason d'Issan, Margaux France 2020 £110
Cassis and red current freshness with a cedar spice. With a long and elegant finish
310. Louis Jadot, Nuits-Saint-Georges, Côtes de Nuits, France 2018 £140
The colour of this wine is a lovely light ruby. The tannins are supple. Les Saints-Georges is a subtle, fruity wine with some notes of spice.
311. Gevrey-Chambertin Bouchard Aîné & Fils, Côtes de Nuits, France 2017/2020, (V) £150
This wine has a full-bodied palate is powerful with spice notes and truffles punctuating the plump ripe fruit flavours.
- Italy
312. Masseria Borgo Dei Trulli Lucale Primitivo Appasimento IGP Puglia, Italy £39
Juicy with incredible concentration. Aromas of blackcurrant, vanilla and chocolate. The palate is velvety, elegant and complex.

313. Uggiano Chianti Riserva Fagiano, Tuscany, Italy (V) £48
A perfectly balanced and elegant Chianti, soft red cherry, plum and warming spices with a touch of balsamic on the finish.
314. Barolo Flori, Piemonte, Italy (V) £60
Robust and complex combining mulberry, ripe strawberry and brown spice with a lengthy finish.

Spain

315. Mirador Rioja Reserva, Tempranillo, Rioja, Spain £45
Distinguished fruits with toasted spice and a delicately balsamic bouquet. This Reserva is an unctuous, delicate vintage, with suitable maturing and ageing.

England

316. Gusbourne Pinot Noir, Kent, England £65
The nose features dark berries, cherry, and smoky earth. On the palate, ripe fruits like cherry, plum, and wild strawberry blend with earthy spice and smoky minerals. Supple tannins add structure, leading to a long, elegant finish.

New World

317. Wee Angus Merlot, Central Victoria, Australia £39
The youthful exuberance of Wee Angus is revealed through the gentle plummy characters of Merlot. A subtle touch of vanillin oak and a generous finish.
318. Nieto Senetiner Malbec, Mendoza, Argentina (v) £45
Soft and juicy with flavours of berries, plum, figs and a smoky vanilla finish.
319. Xanadu, Exmoor Cabernet Sauvignon, Margaret River, Australia £55
Fruits of the forest, cassis and chocolate characters are abundant in this full bodied wine.
320. Veramonte, Organic Carmenera, Colchagua Valley, Chile (V) £45
Notes of raspberry and cherry on the nose, ripe blue and black fruits being added on the medium-bodied palate; a touch of spice on the finish.
321. Banshee Mordecai Red, California, USA £70
A mouthwatering palate of dark berry, plum and hedgerow fruit flavours backed by earthy tones of herb giving way to a spice laden finish.
322. Uovo Cabernet Nebbiolo, Great Southern, Australia £70
Fine tannins, bright acidity with bay leaf and black current. Long sinewy tannins on the finish.
323. Chateau Musar Bekka Valley, Lebanon 2016/2017, £120
An award-winning wine with notes of bramble, blackcurrant and cherry, with soft vanilla, warm spice, and cocoa notes.

401. 'M' Minuty Côtes de Provence, France £46
